November 22-23, 2022 - Fez, Kingdom of Morocco.

The President of "Peace of Art", Ms. Vera Al-Mawla, participated in the "9th Global Forum of the United Nations Alliance of Civilizations", organized by "United Nations Alliance of Civilizations (UNAOC)", under the sponsorship of the Kingdom of Morocco, as a moderator and speaker, where she introduced "Peace of Art" and "We Play for Peace Project" in the panel, which included two high-level officials, namely the former French player of Real Madrid "Christian Karembeu", and the former Minister of Sports in Russia and professional olympic hockey champion "Vyacheslav Fietisov". After that, Ms. Vera opened the discussion panel, which began with questions addressed to both keynote speakers. More than 1,200 young men and women representing more than 90 countries around the world participated in this event, in cooperation with the United Nations Office for Combating Terrorism (**UNOCT Sports & Security**), the United Nations Interregional Crime and Justice Research Institute (UNICRI - United Nations Interregional Crime and Justice Research Institute), and the International Center for Sports and Security (ICSS). Ms. Vera Al-Mawla also participated in a series of youth events and breakout sessions that aimed to set the policy recommendations on PVE through sports, to facilitate learning and participation, and build partnership between global youth as well as highlevel international stakeholders.




POA NGO Management Program
