Mediterannean Women's Ship (MWS)

15-17 April 2023, Beirut.

Within the framework of the Mediterranean Women's Ship program MWS, and under the auspices of the Minister of Youth and Sports, Dr. George Kallas, the President of Peace of Art NGO, Ms. Vera Al-Mawla, and the Executive Director Mr. Ebrahim Yahya, participated in the design and implementation of a training program with the Mediterranean Youth Foundation (MYF). The training included three focused topics: -Gender and stereotypes (with a focus on intersectionality) -Hate speech - Cultural pluralism. They also co-facilitated the sessions of the Union for

the Mediterranean (UFM) to develop the framework of the Mediterranean Women's Ship program expected to be launched in 2025. The training was implemented with activists and experts from Algeria, Egypt, France, Italy, Jordan, Spain, and Lebanon. The program included content developed from Peace of Art's training programs as well as content from UNOY's resource "The Peacebuilders Guide to Tackling Harmful Narratives".

Musawat project is a project implemented by Peace of Art NGO in the Baalbek-Hermel region - the Northern Bekaa area. It included training workshops for youth from 16 to 22 years old to enable them to understand some civic training: human rights, the Human Rights Convention, methods and means of research, discourse methods, advocacy and debate, in addition to some music lessons. These training workshops aim to organize dialogue sessions between youth and religious clerics, in the presence of a group of the region's activities.


The Bakery
